ADMIT CRITERIA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Anyone</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cannot get out without difficulty</li> <li>MD orders needed</li> <li>Skilled need (requires licensed person)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>MD believes the patient probably has life expectancy of less than 6-months if disease follows its "usual course"</li> </ul>
